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Tour example 3: Camping

Day 1: I will pick you up at the airport and we drive straight into the **Kalahari**, here it is commercial farmland with beautifull red dunes and big acacia trees. We will set up our camp at **Bagatelle Game Ranch**, I will assist you in pitching your tents for the first time and getting your sleeping gear in place. There will be time for a walk on the dunes and a first "sundowner" in Namibia. Then we will prepare a meal and sit around a camp fire.

Day 2: I will also help you to pack away all your camping gear, then we leave the Kalahari behind and drive towards the **Namib desert.** Through mountain passes and beautifull landscapes, at **Sesriem camp site** within the Namib Naukluft Park we will put up camp. In the afternoon i will take you on a walk in and around **Sesriem canyon.**

Day 3: we will get up well before sunrise and leave for the huge dunes off Sossusvlei, the colours are best just after sunrise with all its hues and shades. Then I will take you on a walk to my very own "Raini's vlei", here we are all by ourselves with no other tourists in sight, this is how you should experience the desert, in peace and tranquility and not with hordes of other tourist around. Then back to Sesriem, pack up and go to Tsondap Valley Reserve, here you could partake in a dune drive.

Day 4: Today we drive through the Namib desert, Kuiseb canyon and the coastal town of Walvis Bay down to the coast. At the Walvis Bay lagoon we will have a picnic whilst we can see lots of sea birds, then we head for a **B&B in Swakopmund**. Camping at the coast is not nice, to humid and too much wind. You can choose one of the many restaurants for your dinner which is on your own account.

Day 5: This day is free and there is a lot to do, so **many activities** on offer, you will only be able to choose 2, one in the morning and one in the afternoon and then you choose a restaurant once again. **Swakopmund B&B.**

Day 6: We head up the skeleton coast and visit the **seal colony " Cape Cross"** if you have not done a seal and dolfin Tour the day before. Then we head back through the Namib desert again and go to Brandberg, our highest mountain in Namibia. We set up camp at the **Brandberg White Lady Camp**. For sundowners we take a drive sothat we have a great view and if we are very lucky we could see the desert adapted elephants. Now we prepare our meals under the stars and by a campfire again.

Day 7: Up early in the morning so that we can take walk on the wild side, visit the "White Lady" rockpaintings, then we drive to Twyfelfontein with its rock engarvings. We set up camp at Aba Huab Restcamp, still the possibility to see the elephants.

Day 8: This area is full of beautifull and different rock formations: sandstone, granite, dolomite and dolorite and schist. We will visit a petrified forest and then head for **Etosha National Park.**

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We set up camp in **Okaukuejo Restcamp**, here we have a floodlit waterhole and after sunset there is a good chance to see the very rare black rhino and elephants, not to mention all the antilope and giraffe and maybee predators.

Day 9: We go on a gamedrive, from waterhole to waterhole and our destination is **Namutoni Restcamp** in the eastern part of **Etosha National Park**. We will come back to our camp at sunset, that's when the entrance gates close and the tourist are inside and the animals outside.

Day 10: We will go on an early game drive, at sunrise, that's a good time to hopefully see the nocturnal predators before they go for a snooze. Then we leave Etosha and drive down through commercial farmland to **Okonjima Ranch**, here you will have the chance to partake in the activities on offer, **cheetah and leopard tracking** in an open game drive vehicle, this is on your own account.

Day 11: After the morning activity we will break down camp for the last time, by now you are experts , and we head for Winhoek and Berghaus B&B, dinner is your choice and account in one of the many restaurants.

Day 12: I can still take you to the airport, then its good bye and
